### Day in the Life of the President

For this assignment you will be pretending that you are the President of the United States. You will be writing in the first person, as though you are currently the President. You will need to write about what your life is like and some of the things you may do on a daily basis. Your writing can be in any format you would like (journal entry, letter to a friend, news article, etc.) it just must be written in first person.

In your writing you must include certain key words/phrases that deal with the executive branch. These words/phrases do not need to be discussed at length; you only need to mention them in your writing. You must include:

- President      -Vice-President      -Executive order      -"Job" of the executive branch
- 2 of the qualifications to become President      -2 powers of the President

There is no length to this paper. You simply need to write clearly with appropriate grammar, write in the first person, and include all 8 required words/phrases.
